The Board of Commissioners for the City of Pikeville met in a special called session on Monday, November 15, 2010. The meeting was held in the City Hall Meeting Room located at 118 College Street, Pikeville, Kentucky.

(1) There being a quorum present, Mayor Frank Justice called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Commission Members present at roll call were as follows:

- (7) Consider a request to extend a job offer and hire Melanie Stevens for the position of City Clerk contingent upon passing all required pre-employment test that are required for said position at the 1 year rate for said position. - (8) Consider a request to approve the "Agreement for Bond Counsel Services" with William Davis, as submitted for the purpose of securing a 1 million loan from Community Trust Bank for the Thompson Road Development and to authorize the mayor to sign said agreement on behalf of the City of Pikeville. Commissioner Layne made the motion to approve. Commissioner Chaney seconded the motion. Mayor Justice called for comments, there being none the motion passed unanimously. 5-0.
