At a regular adjourned meeting of the city council convened and held in the city hall in the city of Pikeville Ky. on May 10th 1915. Hon. J.M. Williams Mayor and the following councilmen present. T.G. Parker, J.H. Johnson, Linton Trivett, Lank Williams & W.C. Gant.

On motion duly made and carried, the following board of supervisors was appointed. P.F. Truster, M.G. Bowles & Dick Thompson, same being property owners as the law requires, to supervise the tax books for year 1915.

An ordinance ~~fitting~~ fitting the tax levy for year 1915 was presented and adopted by a unanimous vote of the Council for the rate of taxation at 75^{cts} on each one hundred dollars worth of taxable property inside the corporate limits of the city of Pikeville also \$1.50 poll tax on each and every male citizen over 21 years of age living inside the corporation.

By unanimous vote of the Council an ordinance is adopted known as motor cycle ordinance, requiring a bond of \$10.00 and bond of \$200.00 before any one is allowed to operate a motor machine for private use in the city of Pikeville.

It is ordered that the \$10⁰⁰ heretofore paid on salting and license by Lon Ford, be applied for the term already expired and that said license issued to Lon Ford on Dec. 8th 1914, for 1 year, is hereby canceled and held for naught from and after this date.

Ordered that Leuk Williams and Linton Turott be and they are hereby appointed as committee to investigate and figure the cost of building a wall from Main Street to Scott Avenue and to make contract with Mat Amick and about same, the city bearing 1/2 the cost - or furnishing the post and rough work.

On motion J.M. Williams and J.R. Johnson, is appointed and directed to draw an ordinance, concerning hauling, dirt, gravel, crushed stone, sand &c. in the streets and alleys of the city of Pikeville Ky.

J.R. Johnson and J.M. Williams is hereby appointed by the council to take up the matter of condemnation proceedings against Frank & Libby Haller, with the city atty.

The claim of T.J. Williamson against the city for \$252.16 for paving alleys with cross-ties was laid until next regular meeting

It is ordered that J.M. Williams Mayor and the City Clerk renew a note held against the city by The Western Road Machinery Co. for \$260⁰⁰ for street sweepers.

Ordered that T.J. Williamson be and he is hereby granted a permit to use second Street in front of the McCullough building for his convenience in erecting said building leaving a pass way at all times of 10 feet on the opposite side of the street

Ordered that The street committee have sewer run from Elm street upto fronting Sam Herefords residence and also to have the sewer from Elm street to Hoffman Avenue opened up and cleaned out and put in good condition.

Ordered that St. T. Griffith be and he is allowed the sum of \$3⁰⁰ for establishing grade for sewer at Patrick Acons.

Ordered - That the above ordinance fixing license for shows, circuses, etc, shall in no way interfere with the license issued to William Todd, to show in the city. and the Chief Police is hereby directed to notify the Proprietors of the Wm Todd Vanderhill show, that this ordinance does not interfere with license granted him to show in the city.
