

At a regular adjourned meeting of the common council of the city of Pikeville, convened and held in the City hall on Oct. 18<sup>th</sup> 1915. Hon. D.M. Williams Mayor & the following Councilmen present. T.M. Perry, Linton Tarratt, Lamb Williams & W.C. Gost,

The settlement made with Geo S. Thornsbury City Treasurer was approved and ordered recorded in the proper books.

By reason of the resignation of T.D. Parker, a vacancy occurred in the city Council. And on motion duly made the name of J.S. Cline was put before the Council to fill the vacancy. Said Cline was appointed by unanimous vote of the Council to fill the unexpired term.

James J.S. Cline, in open council and took the oath of office as common Councilman for the City of Pikeville Ky. as required by law.

Ordered That,

Lida E. Hellier be and she is allowed the sum of \$12<sup>50</sup> for rent of stray pen upto Oct. 16<sup>th</sup> 1915.

Ordered That,

J.S. Cline be and he is allowed the sum of \$50<sup>00</sup> for rent of office for city hall upto January 1<sup>st</sup> 1916, as per contract,

It is ordered that the City of Pikeville, rent from Lida E. Hellier, the same lot now occupied by the City for stray pen, together with the lot adjoining same for a period of 12 months from Oct. 16<sup>th</sup> 1915 for the sum of \$25<sup>00</sup> to be paid semiannually, and said City is to keep the fencing round said lots in good repair,

It is ordered that the A.J. Hatcher Heirs is hereby granted the right and privilege of building sidewalks from the Public square up main street and also to extend and connect same to the curb of the street paving, said work to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer,

After being duly advertised as required by law. The contract of laying sewer up Kentucky Avenue, was awarded to Sherman Carter, he being the only bidder, at the price of 18 cents per lineal foot for ditching and laying sewer complete.
