

days from the acceptance of the bid by the council, begin work on the telephone and telegraph system to be installed under authority of this franchise, have same completed and giving service to at least one hundred (100) bona fide subscribers, together with long distance connection, within ninety (90) days from the acceptance of said bid as aforesaid.

Sec. X. This ordinance and all rights, privileges, and authority herein granted, shall determine and cease and be absolutely null and void at the end of Twenty (20) years from and after this date.

Sec. XI. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Sec. XII. The right to reject any and all bids is expressly reserved.
