The City Atty. by a unanimous vote of the Council is hereby directed to prepare an ordinance prohibiting the loafing of people around the depot and present same at next meeting for approval.

On motion of J.L. Morgan duly seconded. It is ordered that Geo. Pinson Jr. P.F. Preston and J.M. Triplett be and they are hereby appointed as committee to investigate the advisability of completing the road on the Cemetery Hill and to determine as near as possible the cost of same and damage to property holders through which road have to pass and report their acts at the next meeting of the Council.

Ordered That

Geo. Pinson Jr. be and he is allowed the sum of \$25⁰⁰ salary as City Atty for Jan'y, 1916.

Ordered That Council be adjourned until Thursday - Feb. 10th 1916. at 6:30. P.M.
