Bids for the cleaning of the streets of Asheville N.C. which had been filed with the Clerk, was opened and presented to the Council, which is as follows:

The Council reserving the right to reject any and all bids and it appearing to the Board of Council that all the bids received was too high, and on motion duly made and seconded all the above named bids was rejected.
