O'clock on this day (June 24th 1916) for the purpose of enacting an Ordinance creating and maintaining a public School system and Board of Education as provided by law in and for said City. Of all of which you will take due notice and be present at the time designated.

An Ordinance Creating a system of Public Schools for Pikeville Ky, and providing for the maintenance of same was presented and read before the Board of Council and after due consideration J.D. Meade member of said Board of Council moved the adoption of said ordinance as read said motion was duly seconded by J.L. Morgan and a roll call of the vote stands as follows:

Meade moved the adoption of said ordinance same was duly seconded by J.M. Coleman, and a roll call of the vote being demanded, stands as follows:

J.D. Meade "aye" J.L. Morgan "aye" Virgil Forsythe absent, The above was passed by unanimous vote, and was so declared.
