Consider a request to authorize and award a bid for the Marion Branch Industrial Park Access Road Project, Phase 1 to Bizzack Construction, LLC, which was the low bidder for the base bid and desired alternates of \$1,025,667.75 and to authorize the mayor to have the authority to sign and execute any and all contracts and paperwork necessary to award the bid. This request will also include the approval to issue the notice to proceed for the project contingent upon Bizzack Construction completes all necessary requirements for the bid award. Commissioner Carter made the motion to adopt. Commissioner Chaney seconded the motion. City Manager Blackburn; only comments I would like to make a note mayor that if you look at the bids I gave you the two pages and the base bid for Bizzack was \$554,694.00 and Hawkeye was 618,523.00, so Bizzack was the low bidder and after review of the bids Summit Engineering recommended Bizzack as I did after review as well and my recommendation would be to award the bid to Bizzack Construction, LLC.
