CITY OF PIKEVILLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING MINUTES SEPTEMBER 12, 2022 AT 6:00 P.M.

The Board of Commissioners for the City of Pikeville met in a regular called session on Monday, September 12, 2022. The meeting was held in the City Hall Meeting Room located at 243 Main Street, Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.

There being a quorum present, Mayor James A. Carter called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Commission Members present at roll call were as follows:

MINUTES

The minutes for the previous regular meeting held on August 22, 2022 were in each Commissioner's agenda package. There being no additions or corrections, Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve the minutes as prepared. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion. Mayor Jimmy Carter called for discussion, there being none, the motion carried unanimously. 5-0.

PAYMENT OF CITY BILLS

The City Manager Philip Elswick requested the approval to pay city bills in the amount of \$905,868.35. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for discussion, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0.

CITY ENGINEER

Brad Slone was present and submitted several requests to the Commission for approval.

 Consider a request to award a bid to KVWV Traffic Control, Inc., the only bidder, as submitted, for \$45,000.00 for the 2022 - 2023 Roads and Streets Striping and Marking project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0.

Consider a request to award a proposal to Mountain Enterprises, Inc., which provided the lower quote, as submitted, for \$15,246.66 for repairs to Hambley Boulevard near 7th Street and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, and City Manager Elswick noted that this work is necessary to repair damage to the pavement from a water leak in the area a few months earlier. The motion passed unanimously. 5-0

Consider a request to authorize and approve Steve Thacker Construction, Inc., Change Order No. 1, as submitted, for \$750.00 for the Pauley Bridge Rehabilitation project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Powers made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
- 4. Consider a request to authorize and approve Steve Thacker Construction, Inc., Invoice No. 66, as submitted, for \$85,270.00 for the Pauley Bridge Rehabilitation project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0

- Series 2001 and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Shurtleff seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
- 3. Consider a request to set Enrico Marino's salary at the 8-year rate of pay for his position as Staff Accountant effective with the current pay period. Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
- 4. Consider a request to accept a Group Medical Captive Proposal from Roundstone, as submitted, for health insurance, adopt the proposed contribution rates and grant the City Manager the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner McNamee made the motion. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
- 5. Consider a request to authorize and approve a partnership with Pikeville Independent Schools in a Wilderness Education Program grant application, authorize and approve a Memorandum of Understanding, as submitted, committing to provide holiday assistance through Shop with a First Responder, DARE mentoring at Pikeville High School, and DARE curriculum for 5th, 6th, and 7th grades and grant the Police Chief the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Powers made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comment, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
- 6. Consider a request to declare the parking lot between Appalachian Wireless Arena and the Pike County courthouse as a food zone for use by food trucks specifically as part of a City of Pikeville or Arena sponsored event and the Pavilion parking lot at Adams Lane as a food zone for use by food trucks during the hours of operation of the Farmers Market on Tuesdays and Saturdays. Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, City Manager Elswick stated that this area would be for the new event, Food Truck Fridays. Mayor called for additional comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0

Consider a request to adopt the City of Pikeville Pay Chart dated September 12, 2022 and set Philip Elswick's salary at the 5-year rate for his position as City Manager effective with the current pay period. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
