

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE FISCAL BUDGET
FOR THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR**

ORDINANCE NO. 0-2017-07

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2017, Sever Storms with Straight Line Winds occurred in the City of Pikeville causing major property damage to city property including but not limited to that at The Hambley Complex. In order to make the necessary repairs an emergency is declared to exist with regard to the adoption of this ordinance in order to amend the current budget for financial support to make all necessary repairs. Said emergency being that the damage that occurred was to the baseball and softball fields in the beginning of the season and teams are unable to practiced or play due to the safety and condition of the fields and equipment. Without the immediate necessary repairs the city also has additional risk and liabilities.

WHEREAS, such financial demands for said repairs necessitates the amendment of the 2016-2017 fiscal year budget to reflect certain increases and decreases to revenues and expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE be it ordained by the City of Pikeville that the fiscal budget for the 2016-2017 fiscal year is hereby amended to reflect an increase and or decrease of revenues and /or expenditures as reflected in the attached exhibit entitled "Budget Amendments".

Passed and adopted this 13th day of March, 2017.


