At a regular adjourned meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held in the city hall of said city on the 22nd day of October 1930, the following were present: Mayor, F.A. Connolly, Councilmen, G.H. Francisco, T.N. Huffman Jr., Stafford Sowards, Rush Sword, D.C. Moore and Elmon Walters.

The Minutes of the Common Council, not heretofore read, are now read and approved.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CLEVINGER AND JEFFERSON STREETS, SETTING OUT IN GENERAL TERMS, THE CHARACTER AND EXTENT OF SAID IMPROVEMENT AND PROVIDING THE METHODS FOR PAYMENT OF SAME", is re-introduced and given its second reading, and Councilman, Elmon Walters, moved the adoption of said Ordinance by the City Council, and Councilman, G.H. Francisco, seconded said motion, and upon roll call of the Council, the vote was as follows:

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE SEWER SYSTEM IN THE WILLIAMSON ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, AND APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE APPORTIONMENT AS ESTIMATED AND REPORTED BY THE CITY ENGINEER, AND LEVYING A LOCAL TAX AGAINST THE ABUTTING PROPERTY TO THE AMOUNT OF ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) PER ABUTTING FOOT, TO BE APPLIED TO THE COST OF SAME", is introduced and read, and Councilman, G.H. Francisco, moved the adoption of said Ordinance, and Councilman, T.N. Huffman, seconded said motion, and upon roll call of the Council, the vote was as follows:
