

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular adjourned meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the City hall in said City on the 27th day of October 1930, the following were present: Councilmen, D.C. Moore, Stafford Sowards, G.H. Francisco, and Rush Sword.

The Mayor, F.A. Connolly, being absent from the County, Councilman, D.C. Moore, nominated Councilman, Rush Sword as Mayor Protem, and T.N. Huffman, seconded said motion, and there being no further nominations, upon a roll call of the vote, Rush Sword was elected as Mayor Protem by a unanimous vote of all members present.

Councilman, Rush Sword, now acting as Mayor Protem.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, AND FIXING THE METHOD OF PAYING FOR SAME." is ~~re~~introduced and given its ~~first~~ reading before the City Council, and Councilman, G.H. Francisco, moved the adoption of said Ordinance, and Councilman Stafford Sowards seconded said motion, and upon roll call of the council, the vote was as follows:

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF HIBBARD STREET, SETTING OUT IN GENERAL TERMS THE KIND AND CHARACTER OF SAID IMPROVEMENT AND PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD OF PAYMENT OF SAME", is introduced and read and Councilman, G.H. Francisco, moved the adoption of said Ordinance and Councilman, D.C. Moore, seconded said motion, and upon roll call the vote was as follows:
