

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular adjourned meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the City Hall in said City on the 8th day of November 1930, the following were present: Mayor, F.A. Connolly, Councilmen, D.C. Moore, Rush Sword, Tom Huffman and Stafford Sowards.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF HIBBARD STREET, SETTING OUT IN GENERAL TERMS THE KIND AND CHARACTER OF SAID IMPROVEMENT AND PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD OF PAYMENT OF SAME", is re-introduced and given its second reading before the Common Council, and T.N. Huffman, moved the adoption of said Ordinance by the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, and Councilman, Rush Sword, seconded said motion, and upon a roll call of the council, the vote was as follows:
