An ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE WIDENING AND EXTENSION OF GARRED STREET AND DECLARING THE WIDENING AND EXTENSION OF SAID STREET A NECESSITY AND PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUIRING OF NECESSARY RIGHTS OF WAY AND LAND", was read, and Councilman Uhlan Taylor moved its adoption; Councilman R. S. Johnson seconded said motion.
