REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
July 27, 2009 AT 6:00 P.M.**

The Board of Commissioners for the City of Pikeville met in a regular called session on Monday, July 27, 2009. The meeting was held in the City Hall Conference Meeting Room located at 118 College Street, Pikeville, Kentucky.

**MINUTES**

The minutes for the previous regular meeting held on July 13, 2009 were in each Commission Member's agenda package. There being no additions or corrections, Commissioner Chaney made the motion to approve the minutes as prepared. Commissioner Carter seconded the motion. Mayor Frank Justice called for discussion, there being none the motion carried unanimously.

**PAYMENT OF CITY BILLS**

A list of City Bills totaling \$76,102.37 was presented to the Commission for approval of payment. Commissioner Davis made the motion to approve. Commissioner Chaney seconded the motion. Mayor Frank Justice called for discussion, there being none the motion carried unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS**

- A. Melanie Stevens was present with the Big Sandy Area Development District. Mrs. Stevens reported that everything was moving forward on the Marions' Branch Sewer Project. The project is in the finalization stage waiting for approval on paperwork.

- B. City Engineer's Report: Jack Sykes was present with Summit Engineering, Inc. Mr. Sykes submitted request to approve pay order number 4 to Mountain Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$85,420.79 and authorize payment on the Thompson Road Widening Project. Commissioner Carter made the motion to approve. Commissioner Chaney seconded the motion. Mayor Justice called for further comments, there being none the motion passed unanimously.**
- C. City Manager Report: City Manager Donovan Blackburn asked the commission to consider the following requests.**
- 1. Consider a request to award the bid to Country Wide Ford Dealership at the State Contract Price as bided. Motion includes authorization for the City Manager to sign and execute any paperwork required. Commissioner Layne made the motion to adopt. Commissioner Chaney seconded the motion. Mayor Justice called for comments. Commissioner Davis and Carter both abstain. Mayor Justice called for further comments, there being none the commission approved the bid. 3-2.**
  - 2. Consider a request to adopt proclamation for the Community Ambassador Award and authorize the mayor to sign. Recipients are: Lynn Parrish, William Baird, Paul Patton and William Hambley. Proclamation was read by City Manager Donovan Blackburn into record. Commissioner Layne made the motion to adopt. Commissioner Chaney seconded the motion. Mayor Justice called for roll call. Proclamation was adopted unanimously. 5-0.**
  - 3. Consider request to approve Jesse Bowling for the position of Events/Environmental Coordinator. Mr. Bowlings' position would be from temporary to full time. The full time position would be at the approved rate scale. Mr. Bowlings' hire is contingent upon ability to pass all pre employment testing. Commissioner Chaney made the motion to approve. Commissioner Carter seconded the motion. Mayor called for further discussion, there being none the motion passed unanimously. 5-0.**
  - 4. Consider request to hire Jonathan Turner to the position of general labor at the City of Pikeville per City rate scale, contingent upon his ability to pass all pre employment testing. Commissioner Carter made the motion to approve. Commissioner Chaney seconded the motion. Mayor Justice called for discussion, there being none the motion passed unanimously. 5-0**
  - 5. Consider a request to approve the new job descriptions for Events/Environmental Coordinator and the General Labor job description as submitted for review. Commissioner Chaney made the**

6. Consider request to approve the revised pay scale for the City of Pikeville. Commissioner Chaney made the motion to approve. Commissioner Davis seconded the motion. Mayor called for further comments, there being none the motion passed. 5-0.

Consider request to submit for a 10 day extension with the NRCS in order to get all project completed within required time frame and to authorize the City Manager to sign any required paperwork necessary to request said extension. Commissioner Chaney made the motion to approve. Commissioner Layne seconded the motion. Mayor Justice called for comments, there being none the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
  8. Consider request for closed session for discussion of personnel, legal and economic development issues. Commissioner Davis made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Carter seconded the motion to adjourn. Mayor called for adjournment. 5-0
  9. Commissioner Davis made the motion to re convene. Commissioner Layne seconded the motion. Mayor Justice called for discussion, there being none the motion passed unanimously. 5-0 Mayor called the session into order.
