Regular Meeting  
September 09, 2008 at 12:00 AM  
Pikeville City Hall

Main Street Director, Jennifer Bunch called the meeting to order. Members present were Eddie Jackson, Jennifer Brown, Jerry Johnson, Minta Chaney, and John Doug Hayes as proxy for Wayne T. Rutherford. Others present were Jennifer Bunch.

Jennifer Brown made a motion to accept the minutes from the August 12<sup>th</sup> meeting. Eddie Jackson seconded the motion. Minutes were accepted as is.

Jerry Johnson made a motion to accept Randy Roberts as the Chairperson. Eddie Jackson seconded the motion. Randy Roberts will be the Chairperson of the Pikeville Main Street Renaissance Program.

The board agreed that December 6<sup>th</sup> was a terrific date for the Christmas Parade. Jennifer Brown asked what Main Street could do to be a bigger part of the parade. Minta thought a float would be a good idea. She made the statement that something visible that showed what the Main Street Program was all about would be best.

The county holds a Christmas in the Court House. The board will consider being a part of this during our next board meeting. Christmas in the Court House consists of 2 days when the court house is open to the public between the hours of 12-2:00. Local high school choirs perform, hot chocolate and cider is provided as guests tour the trees and decorations in the court house. Eddie made a suggestion to notify daycares about the event to get more involved with Christmas Events.

Minta suggested having businesses downtown participate by having different themed Christmas trees in each business and having the public bid on the trees or judge the trees.

John suggested a walking Christmas tour downtown.

Jerry Johnson wanted the director to do a study on the feasibility of these projects and bring it to the table at the next meeting. Jennifer Bunch will do the study.

Jennifer Bunch mentioned a façade program that she is working on with the economic development director, Minta Chaney. Minta Chaney said the goal is to update without destroying.

Jennifer Bunch explained September's work plan.

Jerry Johnson made a motion to adjourn. John seconded the motion.
