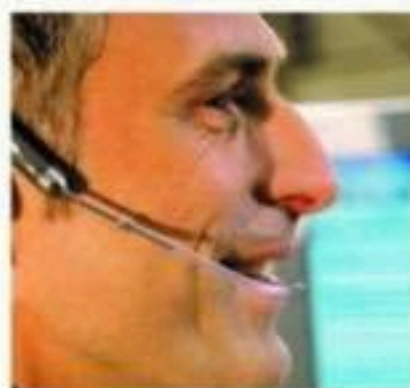
9-1-1 Dispatchers Needed!
