AGENDA ITEM I. INTENT ANNEXATION READING

City Manager Donovan Blackburn read the first reading in its entirety an ordinance declaring the intention of the City of Pikeville to annex certain unincorporated territory lying adjacent to the present city corporate limits and comprising of approximately 163.95 acres extending the city's corporate limits onto US23 north at the Pike/Floyd county line.
