CITY OF PIKEVILLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING MINUTES March 14, 2022 AT 6:00 P.M.

The Board of Commissioners for the City of Pikeville met in a regular called session on Monday, March 14, 2022. The meeting was held in the City Hall Meeting Room located at 243 Main Street, Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.

The minutes for the previous regular meeting held on February 28, 2022 were in each Commissioner's agenda package. There being no additions or corrections, Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve the minutes as prepared. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Jimmy Carter called for discussion, there being none, the motion carried unanimously. 5-0.

PAYMENT OF CITY BILLS
