Ordered that The sewer line be extended from the back of Geo. S. Thornsbury's lot up to property line of O.H. Brown and to be laid out of 6 in. cast iron pipe.

Ordered That

J.H. Call. be and is hereby authorized and employed to order the pipe for the above sewer extension. The City is to pay for pipe and the expense of laying same. said O.H. Brown is to dig the ditch and fill the same.

Ordered that G.S. Thornsbury City Treasurer, be and he is hereby directed to pay to First National Bank the sum of \$ 872.60 for the following street paving bonds and interest up to Apr 1<sup>st</sup> 1915.
