The object of this meeting is to accept the resignations of W. H. Elliott as City atly and T. G. Parker as Councilman.

The written resignation of W. H. Elliott was presented to the Council and on motion duly made and seconded said resignation was accepted, and said W. H. Elliott was thereby released from further duties as City atly for the City of Pikeville Ky.

The written resignation of T. G. Parker as Councilman for the City was presented to the Council and on motion duly made and seconded said resignation was accepted, and T. G. Parker was thereby released from further duties as Common Councilman for the City of Pikeville Ky.

It becoming necessary by the resignation of W. H. Elliott City atly, to fill the vacancy occurred by said resignation in the usual way. Upon motion duly made and seconded, the name John A. Casier was put in nomination, there being no further nominations, the vote was taken in the regular way, so Mr. Casier was declared elected to fill out the unexpired term of City atly, caused by the resignation of W. H. Elliott, by unanimous vote of said Council.

John A. Casier, after being duly elected <sup>City atly</sup> by the common council of the City of Pikeville Ky., to fill out the unexpired term, which vacancy was caused by the resignation of W. H. Elliott, presented himself this day July 19<sup>th</sup> 1915, and took the oath of office as required by law.
