J.M. Hatcher, City Attorney be allowed the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars, which which to pay writ tax on suits filed by the city of Pikeville, Ky., against persons failing to pay street paving contracts on Kelley Bros. paving. J

ORDERED THAT:

Earl & John Scott be allowed the sum of Twenty Two and 69/100 (\$22.69) Dollars, for repairs to street sweeper, as per bills rendered.

The bill of the New Wagon Shop is presented and upon motion made, seconded and carried, said bill is referred to the City Clerk to check up and see if said bill has ever been paid, and not, the clerk is directed to issue voucher for said bill.

On motion, made seconded and carried, Council is adjourned until the next regular meeting date, October, 4th, 1927.
