

## MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

K At a Special Called meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the city hall in said city, the following were present: Mayor, F.A. Connolly, Councilmen, T.N. Huffman Jr., G.H. Francisco, and Rush Sword, which meeting was held pursuant to the following call, issued by the Mayor.

You are hereby notified that there will be a meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, held at the city hall in said city, on the 22nd day of July 1930 at 7:30 o'clock p.m. for the purpose of appointing and electing a member of the Board of Equilization for the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, for year 1930, to fill the vacancy caused by the refusal of A.M. Burke, to act as a member of said Board heretofore appointed, and your presence at said meeting is requested.

All of which you will take due notice and govern yourselves accordingly

It appearing that A.M. Burke, having failed to qualify as a member of the City Board of Equilization for the year 1930, and there now being a vacancy in said Board, Councilman, G.H. Francisco, nominated and moved the election of Garfield Sowards, as a member of the City Board of Equilization for the year 1930, and there being no further nominations, upon a roll call of the council the vote was as follows:

The result of the vote being announced, the Mayor declared the said Garfield Sowards elected as a member of the City Board of Equilization for the year 1930.

Garfield Sowards being present in open Council accepted said appointment and election and took the oath of office as required by law.
