

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular adjourned meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the city hall in said city on the 17th day of December 1931, the following were present: Mayor, F.A. Connolly, Councilmen, C.D. Jacobs, Mack Matney, T.E. Rogers, Stafford Sowards, Uhlan Taylor and R.G. Wells,

An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance fixing and setting the salaries of the following officers of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, to-wit: Chief of Police, Policemen, City Attorney, City Clerk, City Treasurer, City Assessor, and City Engineer, for the term beginning First Monday in January 1932, and repealing all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith", is presented and read, and Councilman, C.D. Jacobs, moved the adoption of said Ordinance and said motion being duly seconded by ~~C.D. Jacobs~~ Uhlan Taylor, upon a roll call of the council, the vote was as follows:

The result of the vote being announced by the clerk, the Mayor declared said motion carried and said Ordinance adopted.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, it is ordered that the offices of Policemen be voted on and filled, separate, one at a time.

Councilman, C.D. Jacobs, nominated J.C. Williamson for the office of Day Policeman and Traffic Officer, and there being no further nominations, and the nomination of J.C. Williamson being seconded by Mack Matney, upon a roll call the vote was as follows:

Councilman, Uhlan Taylor, nominated W.B. Pinson for the office of Night Policeman and said nomination being duly seconded by C.D. Jacobs, and there being no further nominations, upon a roll call of the council the vote was as follows:
