

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held in the city hall in the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, on the 20th day of December, 1932, the following were present:

Mayor, F. A. Connolly, and
Councilmen, R. G. Wells, C. D. Jacobs, Stafford Sowards,
T. E. Rogers and Uhlan Taylor.
Councilmen, Mack Matney, was absent.

Robert Ratliff appeared before the council and asked to be exonerated from the payment of taxes on the sum of \$500.00 for the year 1932, and said matter was referred to the city attorney, city clerk, C. D. Jacobs and T. E. Rogers, who shall report their recommendation to the council.

R. G. Wells introduced an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the closing of that part of Division Street between the east end of the present brick pavement on the courthouse square and Big Sandy River at or near the upper ford as it was formerly known", and moved that said ordinance be passed and adopted. C. D. Jacobs seconded said motion. Upon roll call the vote was as follows:

Vernon Sanders be, and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$7.50 for serving two days as special policeman, December 11-12, 1932, payable out of General Expenditure Budget Fund.

ORDERED THAT:

W. V. Young be, and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$7.50 for serving two days as special policeman, December 11-12, 1932, payable out of General Expenditure Budget Fund.

ORDERED THAT:

A. S. Ratliff be, and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$3.15, commission on 1932 tax sale, payable out of General Expenditure Budget Fund.
