At a Speival or Called meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held in the city hall in the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, on the 3rd day of July, 1944, the following were present:

Charlie Sowards seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

J. K. Hatmaker moved that applications be received, bonds approved and the clerk authorized to issue licenses when State licenses have been exhibited to him to the following:

E. & K. Restaurant - beer;
Ted H. Coleman - beer;
John C. Poulos - beer;
Mrs. T. H. Deskins - beer;
Loyal Order of Moose - beer;
Christ Petrou - beer.
Charlie Sowards seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

J. K. Hatmaker moved that applications be received, bonds approved and the clerk authorized to issue licenses to the following:

W. D. Snell (The Tavern) - whiskey;
W. D. Snell (Liberty Dispensary on Caroline Avenue) - whiskey;
W. D. Snell - beer (in Tavern Building).
H. L. Robinson seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried council is adjourned until its next regular meeting.
