

at a regular meeting of the Common Council of the city of Pikeville, Kentucky, held in the city hall in the city of Pikeville, Kentucky, on the 15th day of August 1922, the following were present: Councilman Walter Hatcher, Rush Sward, R.H. Lyons and E.M. Hatfield.

Walter Hatcher was elected mayor pro tem by unanimous vote.

Ordered that

John Davidson he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$45.62 for repairing Sycamore street during June, 1922.

Ordered that

John Davidson he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$50.00 for repairing curb on Elm Street during June, 1922 (Foothills Brothers).

Ordered that

John Davidson he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$25.00 for building man hole on Elm Street during June, 1922.

Councilman John A. McCowan now present.

R.H. Lyons introduced a resolution entitled "A Resolution providing for the improvement of certain side walks in the city of Pikeville, Ky." and moved that said resolution be passed and adopted. E.M. Hatfield seconded said motion. Upon roll call the vote was as follows: R.H. Lyons, yes; E.M. Hatfield, yes; Rush Sward, yes; John A. McCowan, yes; Carl Young, absent. Said motion carried.

John A. McCowan moved that the Sandy Valley Light & Power Company be directed to install three street lights on Myra-Burner Avenue, one to be placed at head near river bank, and two more lights to be placed at necessary places on said Avenue. R.H. Lyons seconded said motion. Upon roll call the vote was as follows: John A. McCowan, yes; R.H. Lyons, yes; E.M. Hatfield, yes; Carl Young, absent; Rush Sward, yes. Said motion carried.

John A. McCowan moved that W.L. Morris and W.M. Austin be appointed on the Board of Fox Supervisors for the year 1922 in lieu of Zack Justice and G.W. Brewster who failed to act. E.M. Hatfield seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

R.H. Lyons introduced an ordinance entitled "An ordinance accepting Caroline Avenue in the City of Pikeville, Kentucky" and moved that said ordinance be passed and adopted and said street accepted. E.M. Hatfield seconded said motion. Upon roll call the vote was as follows: R.H. Lyons, yes; E.M. Hatfield, yes; Rush Sward, yes; John A. McCowan, yes; Carl Young, absent. Said motion carried and said ordinance was adopted.

R.H. Lyons introduced a resolution entitled "A resolution for the improvement of Caroline Avenue in the city of Pikeville, Kentucky" and moved that said resolution be passed and adopted. E.M. Hatfield seconded said motion. Upon roll call the vote was as follows: R.H. Lyons, yes; E.M. Hatfield, yes; Rush Sward, yes; John A. McCowan, yes; Carl Young, absent. Said motion carried.

Walter Hatcher tendered and had filed his resignation as city Councilman, which is in words and figures as follows:

John A. McCowan moved that said resignation be accepted. R.H. Lyons seconded said motion, which carried unanimously upon motion made, duly seconded and carried. John A. McCowan was elected mayor pro tem.

E.M. Hatfield moved that J.S. Cline be appointed as a member of the City Council of the city of Pikeville, Kentucky, to fill the unexpired term of Walter Hatcher. R.H. Lyons seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

Ordered that

G.L. Ratliff he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$50.00 for salary as city attorney for month of July, 1922.

Ordered that

Butler Bates he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$125.00 for salary as policeman for month of July, 1922.

Ordered that

J.M. Hatcher he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$49.40 for salary and services as city clerk for month of July, 1922.

Ordered that

James McWayne he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$135.00 for salary as chief of police for month of July, 1922.

Ordered that

J.S. Marrs he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$60.00 for salary as police judge for month of July, 1922.

Ordered that

J. S. Mans he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$40<sup>00</sup> for rent for police judge's office for month of July, 1922.

Ordered that

J. S. Cline he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$150<sup>00</sup> for rent for city hall for year 1922.

Ordered that

J. S. Thompson he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$33<sup>25</sup> for salary as city treasurer for months of January, February and first 21 days of March, 1922.

Ordered that

R. D. Housler he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$66<sup>25</sup> for salary as city treasurer for last nine days of March and months of April, May, June, July and August, 1922.

J. S. Cline appeared in open council and took the oath of office as required by law as city councilman and accepted the appointment as a member of the city council of the city of Pottsville, Kentucky, to fill the unexpired term of Walter Hatcher, resigned.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried Council is adjourned until its next regular meeting.

Carl Young moved that the streets and alleys heretofore ordered and directed paved by ordinance herein be let as provided in said ordinance to contract to the lowest bidder on the 23rd day of October, 1922, bids to be received up until the hour of six o'clock P.M. on said date, and that same be advertised as provided by said ordinance. E. M. Hatfield seconded said motion, which carried.

Green Slope he and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$109<sup>50</sup> for constructing one crossing and retaining wall on 8th Street (near Bob McTay's store) during June, 1922.

Carl Young moved that the city Clerk be directed to make settlement with Chief of police and Ben Dawson and all officers that have collected money belonging to the city. E. M. Hatfield seconded said motion, which carried.

City Clerk's settlements with chief of police and police judge for months of April, May, June, July and August, 1922, were filed, accepted and approved.
