At a regular adjourned meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville held in the city hall in the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, on the 1st day of December, 1923, the following were present: Mayor, J. L. Morgan and Councilmen, J. S. Cline, T. J. Marshall, Rush Sward, E. M. Hatfield, and W. L. Morris.

The minutes of the meetings of November 27, 1923, November 28, 1923, November 29, 1923, and November 30, 1923 were read and approved.

The Mayor vetoed the water contract and the appointment of the four water works and sewer commissioners, for the reason that he believes it to be against public policy.

J. M. Hatfield, city clerk, presented and had filed statement with James Matney, Tax Collector, for the collection of City School and street apportionment warrants for the year 1922. J. S. Cline moved that same be filed, which was done and ordered to lay over thirty days for exceptions. Rush Sward seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

J. S. Cline called up and moved for readoption over the Mayor's veto the appointment of four water works and sewer commissioners to wit Tom Williamson, Clinton Trivette, G. W. Green, Rush Sward seconded said motion, upon roll call the vote was as follows: J. S. Cline, aye; Rush Sward, yes; E. M. Hatfield, yes; T. J. Marshall, yes; John A. McCowan, absent; W. L. Morris, yes. Said motion carried.

W. L. Morris moved that J. S. Cline's name be added to the above list of commissioners for water works and sewer boards and stand as originally passed. E. M. Hatfield seconded said motion, upon roll call the vote was as follows: W. L. Morris, yes; E. M. Hatfield, yes; Rush Sward, yes; T. J. Marshall, yes;

John A. McCowan, absent; J. S. Cline, not voting. Said motion carried.

The committee on resolutions appointed by the mayor to draft resolution, made their report, which is in words and figures as follows:
