At a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky held in the city hall in the city of Pikeville, Kentucky, on the 17th day of March, 1925, the following were present: Mayor J. A. Thompson, and councilmen, L. A. Duty, P. Thompson, A. T. Ratliff, R. S. Johnson and K. J. Day.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried Council granted Pikeville Bottling Company permit to make connection with a two inch water main of the water works system of the City of Pikeville at the Bottling Company's expense, same to be done under the supervision of the Water Engineer.

It is ordered that any and all citizens and residents of the City of Pikeville be, and they are permitted to connect with the city's water mains, provided such connections are made under the supervision of the Water engineer.

The Mayor appointed K. J. Day, P. S. Johnson and A. T. Ratliff as committee to inspect work done by Campbell Construction Company, and for which it has heretofore rendered bill in the sum of \$3940<sup>52</sup>, and investigate the items of said bill, and report to the council at its next meeting.

Ordered that

National Sewer Company be and it is hereby allowed the sum of \$500<sup>00</sup> for premium on city treasurer's bond due March 18, 1925.

A. T. Ratliff introduced an ordinance entitled "An ordinance regulating parking of motor vehicles in front of places of business and fixing a penalty for violation thereof," and moved that said ordinance be passed and adopted. K. J. Day seconded said motion, upon roll call the vote was as follows: A. T. Ratliff, yes; K. J. Day, yes; L. A. Duty, no; R. Thompson, no; P. S. Johnson, no; J. S. Barker, said motion not having received a majority of votes cast, the mayor declared not passed and adopted.

Deputy city engineer, W. Kemp Walker, presented and had filed plat showing lower end of Scott Avenue being a portion of the addition to city of Pikeville, dated August, 1908 and recorded in Deed Book 47, page 640, Pike County Court Clerk's Office.

Various bids having been filed and read in open council for the job of street cleaner, K. J. Day moved that the bid by Robert Williams be accepted and that contract be entered into with him for said purpose, said contract to be approved by Council. L. A. Duty seconded said motion, which carried. Last bid is in words and figures as follows:

"Pikeville, Ky., March 17, 1925,

City Council, City of Pikeville;  
I offer as a bid for cleaning streets \$200<sup>00</sup> per month, also agree to personally oversee the work and put sufficient teams on this work necessary to keep the streets cleaned at any and all times, and failure to comply with this work satisfactory to the street committee, will surrender same upon due notice.
