At a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the city hall in said city on the 17th day of September 1929, the following were present, Mayor, Geo. Pinson Jr., Councilmen, Richard Thompson, Oscar Jackson and G.H. Francisco.

The bond of Albert Bentley, dated 21st day of August 1929, in the sum of Five Thousand Six Hundred (\$5600.00) Dollars, with the Fidelity & Casualty Company of New York, for the faithful performance of the Sewer Contract awarded to him, for the construction of the sewer in the north end of the city, and upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, said bond is approved and ordered filed.

The bond and contract of Frank Hall, dated the 8th day of August 1929, in the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars, with the Fidelity & Casualty Company of New York, for the faithful performance of the Street Cleaning Contract awarded him, and also his contract with the city to perform said work of date the 6th day of August 1929, is presented and read and upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, said contract and bond is approved and ordered filed.

Councilman, I.E. Brooks now present and acting.

Various citizens living on Park Street, file request for street paving on Park Street, to north property line of Joe Justice, and upon motion duly made seconded and carried, said petition is filed, and the city attorney directed to prepare such ordinances as are necessary to let the contract for paving of said street.

Councilman, G.H. Francisco, moved that Campbell-Johnson Company be allowed the sum of \$2030.60, for Sewer Pipe delivered to the city of Pikeville, Kentucky, as per contract and as per Engineer's estimate, and said motion being duly seconded, upon a roll call the vote was as follows:

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, it is ordered that Straton & Stephenson be discharged as counsel for the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, and that the City Attorney is directed to take full charge of all suits for and against the city of Pikeville, Kentucky.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the City Attorney is directed to prepare necessary Ordinances to extend sewer on Jefferson Street, and have same ready for consideration at the next regular meeting of the Board.

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On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the citizens living on Park Street are granted the right to contract for the paving of Park Street, said paving to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer.

ORDERED THAT:

Straton & Stepehnson be allowed the sum of Three Hundred and Forty (\$340.00) Dollars, in full for services as Assistant City Attorney, payable out of the General Expenditure Budget Fund.

ORDERED THAT:

W.T. Griffith be allowed the sum of Seventy (\$70.00) Dollars, for 7 days work on outfall sewer, payable out of the general expenditure budget fund.

ORDERED THAT:

W.R. Fuller be allowed the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars, for services as member of the Board of Supervisors. payable out of Gen. Expt. Budget fund.

ORDERED THAT:

J.D. Caudill be allowed the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars, for services as member of the Board of Supervisors, payable out of Gen. Exp. Budget Fund.

ORDERED THAT:

F.E. Bevins be allowed the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars, for services as member of the Board of Supervisors, payable out of Gen. Exp. Budget Fund.

ORDERED THAT:

J.E. Stanley be allowed the sum of Three Hundred Twenty Five and 65/100 (\$325.65) Dollars, for lodging and dieting city prisoners from January 1st, 1929, to July 1st, 1929, payable out of Feeding and Care of Prisoners Budget Fund.

ORDERED THAT:

J.E. Sanders be allowed the sum of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars, for services with Board of Supervisors, payable out of Gen. Exp. Budget Fund.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, council is adjourned until the next regular meeting date.
