At a regular adjourned meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the city hall in said city on the 9th day of May 1930, the following were present: Mayor, F.A. Connolly; Councilmen G.H. Francisco, T.N. Huffman, Stafford Sowards, Rush Sword and Elmon Walters.

Councilman, Rush Sword, moved that L.J. May be employed as Attorney and Counsel to represent the City of Pikeville, in all matters wherein the city is involved until the end of the year 1930, and Councilman, G.H. Francisco moved that A.S. Ratliff be employed as Attorney and Counsel to represent the City of Pikeville, in all matters wherein the city is involved until the end of the year 1930, and both motions being duly seconded, the vote was taken between L.J. May and A.S. Ratliff, as follows:

The result of the vote being announced by the clerk, the Mayor thereupon declared that A.S. Ratliff having received a majority of the votes present and cast, that the said A.S. Ratliff is employed as Attorney and Counsel to represent the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, in all matters wherein the City is involved, until the end of the year 1930

Councilman, G.H. Francisco, nominated A.S. Ratliff, as City Attorney, to fill the unexpired term of Zach Justice resigned, and there being no further nominations, upon a roll call of the council, the vote was as follows:
