

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular meeting of the Common Council of the city of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the city hall in said city on the 15th day of July 1930, the following were present: Mayor, F.A. Connolly, Councilmen, D.C. Moore, G.H. Francisco, T.N. Huffman Jr., Rush Sword and Stafford Sowards.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BUDGET COMMITTEE'S REPORT FOR THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE KENTUCKY, FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1930, AND ENDING JUNE, 30, 1931; AND SETTING FORTH ESTIMATED REVENUES FOR SAID CITY FOR SAID YEAR, AND CLASSIFYING THE VARIOUS EXPENDITURES OF SAME." is presented and read to the City Council, and Councilman, Rush Sword moved that same be adopted by the City Council of the city of Pikeville, and said motion being duly seconded by T.N. Huffman Jr., upon a roll call of the council, the vote was as follows:

An Ordinance entitled " AN ORDINANCE LAYING A LEVY ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, FOR CITY PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 1930, AND FIXING THE RATE THEREOF AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO MAKE TAX TICKET BOOKS ACCORDINGLY", is presented and read and councilman G.H. Francisco, moved the adoption of said Ordinance by the City Council and said motion being duly seconded by T.N. Huffman Jr., upon a roll call of the council, the vote was as follows:
