

## MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the city hall in said city, on the 6th day of January 1931, the following were present: Mayor, F.A. Connolly, Councilmen, D.C. Moore, Stafford Sowards, T.N. Huffman, and Rush Sword.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the reading of the minutes is dispensed with until the next regular meeting.

A report on City Tax sales and collections by the County Court clerk is presented and read by the clerk and upon motion duly made, seconded, and carried, same is ordered filed.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the Paving of Clevinger and Jefferson Streets, is ordered and directed to be re-advertised for bids.

The City Clerk is appointed as a Committee to make an investigation and report on the Charley Keyser Sr., property tax refund, and have said report ready for consideration by the Council at its next regular meeting.

An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance relating to and regulating the sale, distribution of milk and milk products in the City of Pikeville, Prohibiting the Sale of Adulterated and Misbranded Milk and Milk Products, Regulating and Inspection of Dairy Farms and Milk Plants, The Testing, Phacarding, Pasteurization Regrading, Distribution, Sale and Denaturing of Milk and Milk Products, providing for the construction of future Dairies and Milk Plants, the enforcement of this Ordinance, and the fixing of penalties", is introduced and read, and Councilman, Rush Sword, moved that said Ordinance be adopted and Councilman, D.C. Moore, seconded said motion, upon a roll call of the council the vote was as follows:

W.J. Ward be allowed the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars, for two and a half days work on Hibbard Street and making report on Post Office location. payable out of General Expenditure Budget Fund.

## ORDERED THAT:

General Service Garage be allowed the sum of Thirteen and 79/100 (\$13.79) Dollars, for invoices of 22-18, 20 and 31 1930, payable out of Fire Dept., Budget Fund.

## ORDERED THAT:

Kentucky & W.Va. Power Company be allowed the sum of Four and 14/100 (\$4.14) Dollars, for light for city hall for month of December 1930, payable out of General Expenditure Budget Fund.

## ORDERED THAT:

T.N. Huffman Coal Company be allowed the sum of Six (\$6.00) Dollars, for invoices of 12-9 and 12-18, 1930, payable out of Fire Department Budget Fund.

## ORDERED THAT:

## ORDERED THAT:

Tom Fields be allowed the sum of One Hundred Twenty Five (\$125.00) Dollars, for salary as Service employee for water Department for month of December 1930, payable out of Water Fund.

## ORDERED THAT:

Kentucky & W.Va., Power Company be allowed the sum of Three Hundred Fifteen and 64/100 (\$315.64) Dollars, for power furnished water Department for month of December 1930, payable out of Water Fund.

## ORDERED THAT:

T.E. Newton be allowed the sum of Thirty Two and 98/100 (\$32.98) Dollars, as current expense account of Supt. of Water Dept. for month of December 1930, payable out of Water Fund.
