

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular adjourned meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held at the city hall in said city on the 27th day of June 1931, the following were present: Mayor, F.A. Connolly, Councilmen, D.C. Moore, G.H. Francisco and ~~XXXXX~~ Elmon Walters.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the City Attorney is directed to prepare and have ready for consideration by the Council at its next regular meeting, an Ordinance regulating the driving of cattle through the city of Pikeville, Kentucky.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS FOR THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, TO-WIT: CHIEF OF POLICE; CITY ATTORNEY; CITY CLERK; CITY TREASURER; CITY ASSESSOR, AND CITY ENGINEER, AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR SELECTION AND ELECTION BY THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH", is presented and read; councilman, G.H. Francisco, moved the adoption of said Ordinance and councilman Elmon Walters seconded said motion. Upon a roll call of the council, the vote was as follows:

The result of the vote being announced by the clerk, the Mayor thereupon declared said motion carried.

It appearing that there is a deficit in the Officers Salary Budget fund for the year 1930, and also that there is a surplus in the General Expenditure Budget Fund. Upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, the city Treasurer is ordered and directed to transfer by proper vouchers, the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, from the General Expenditure Budget Fund and credit same to the Officers Salary Budget Fund for the budget year of 1930-31.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the City Attorney is directed to prepare contract to be signed by the State Highway Department, whereby they may obtain water for their office building beyond the city limits from the present City Water System.
