

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF POLICEMEN, POLICE JUDGE, SUPERINTENDENT OF THE WATER DEPARTMENT, HELPER IN WATER DEPARTMENT AND CARETAKER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION I. That the salary of the Police Judge of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, shall be eighty dollars (\$80.00) per month.

SECTION II. That the salaries of the policemen of Pikeville, Kentucky, shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month.

SECTION III. That the salary of the Superintendent of the Water Department shall be One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per month, and that of helper of the water department shall be \$100.00 per month.

SECTION IV. That the salary of the caretaker of the Fire Station shall be Seventy Five (\$75.00) per month.

SECTION V. That the provisions of this ordinance shall apply only to the officials and employees mentioned in this ordinance.

SECTION VI. That this ordinance shall take effect when duly passed by the council, approved by the mayor and posted by the city clerk, as is required by law.

SECTION VII. That this ordinance shall not apply to any one now filling any of the offices or positions mentioned in this ordinance.

SECTION VIII. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
