At a call meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held in the city hall in the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, on the 10th day of May, 1934, the following were present:

A special meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville is called to convene at the city hall at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening, May 10, 1934, for the purpose of passing ordinance entitled the ordinance providing for the widening of Cline St.

Arthur Fields introduced an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE providing for the widening of Cline Street, and declaring the widening of said street a necessity, and providing for the acquiring of necessary rights of way and land", and moved that said ordinance be passed and adopted. Rush Sword seconded said motion. Upon roll call the vote was as follows:

The mayor declared said motion carried and said ordinance duly passed and adopted.
