

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

The mayor declared said motion carried and said ordinance duly passed and adopted.

H. E. Syck moved that the city attorney be directed to prepare an ordinance amending parking ordinances, including the word "park ways". Clyde Childers seconded said motion, which carried.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried the city attorney is directed to investigate matter of water deposits and prepare ordinance governing same, if he deems necessary, and report to the council.

R. P. Robinson appeared before the council and asked that he be given permission to have his beer licenses transferred as to location, he having changed location of his business.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried the city attorney is directed to prepare ordinance amending beer ordinance, permitting transfer of license when location is changed only, subject to approval of the council.

The four policemen appeared in open council and asked that they each be given two weeks' vacation.

Arthur Fields moved that the four policemen be each given a two weeks' vacation, one day man and one night man only to be off at a time. G. C. Call seconded said motion, which carried.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried the city attorney is directed to prepare ordinance relating to peddlers, covering what has not been covered by previous ordinances.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried council is adjourned until Thursday night, August 23, 1934.
