ORDERED THAT:

Nannie Brown be, and she is hereby allowed the sum of \$4.90 for laundry bill for city jail for the month of December, 1935, payable out of Criminal Prosecution Budget Fund.

ORDERED THAT:

Ed Auxier be, and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$115.96 for dieting city prisoners for the month of December, 1935, payable out of Criminal Prosecution Budget Fund.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried Council is adjourned until its next regular meeting.
