WITNESSETH, That the party of the second part for and in consideration of the payments hereinafter specified and agreed to by the party of the first part, hereby agrees to prepare plans, specifications, bid forms, contract agreements, bond forms, and notices for the receiving of bids covering the planning and construction of a building including a gymnasium and class rooms for the Pikeville City Board of Education for which the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, and the Pikeville City Council are Sponsors for the purpose of securing a PWA or Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works loan or loan from any department of the government of the United States of America which is referred to as "Docket Ky-1196-DS, School, Pikeville, Kentucky."

The party of the second part agrees to prepare all plans and specifications, as set out above, subject to the approval of the State Supervisor of Education.

The party of the first part agrees to pay the party of the second part for the preparation of said plans, specifications and other information, as set out above, and for such general supervision of the project as the party of the second part may deem necessary during the construction of said project, a sum equal to five (5%) per cent of the cost of construction.

The sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars to be due and payable upon the approval of the Gymnasium and School Foundation Plans by the State Supervisor of Education, and Thirteen Hundred and Fifty (\$1350.00) Dollars to be paid when the plans for the superstructure of the gymnasium and class rooms are completed and approved by the State Supervisor of Education. The sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars to be paid on the first Tuesday of each month after construction work has actually begun until the completion or final acceptance of this project; but such sums so paid shall not exceed a sum greater than a sum equal to five (5%) per cent of the total construction cost of said project. In the event, that upon the completion of the said project, the total of the amounts paid the party of the second party by the party of the first part is not a sum equal to five (5%) per cent of the total construction cost of said project, then the party tof the first part shall pay the party of the second part the difference between the total of the sums so paid and a sum equal to five (5%) per cent of the total construction cost of the project as above set out.
