NO-I- AN ORDINANCE LAYING A LEVY ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, FOR CITY PURPOSES, FOR THE YEAR OF 1938. AND FIXING THE RATE THEREOF AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO MAKE TAX BOOKS ACCORDINGLY.

NO-II* AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A LICENSE FOR WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS OF MOTOR OIL, MACHINE OIL, OR ANY OTHER KIND OF OIL IN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE.

NO-III- AN ORDINANCE FIXING A LICENSE FEE FOR WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS OF CANDY, PEANUTS, POTATO CHIPS OR SIMILAR ARTICLES SOLD IN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE.

NO*IV- AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENING OF WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS OF PACKING HOUSE PRODUCTS.

NO-V- AN ORDINANCE FIXING A LICENSE FEE FOR WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS OF AUTOMOBILE PARTS, AND AUTOMOBILE ACCESSORIES.

NO-VI- AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENING OF WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS OF ICE CREAM, ICE CREAM PRODUCTS AND SIMILAR ARTICLES, IN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE. KY.

NO*VII- AN ORDINANCE FIXING A LICENSE FEE ON WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS OF BARBERS SUPPLIES, OR BEAUTY PARLOR SUPPLIES.

NO*VIII- AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENING OF WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS OF CIGARETTES, CIGARETTE MATERIALS, CIGARS, CHEWING TOBACCO, SNUFF, SMOKING TOBACCO, OR ANY OTHER TOBACCO MATERIALS, OR TOBACCO PRODUCTS, OR SMOKING SUPPLIES, IN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE.

NO*IX- AN ORDINANCE FIXING A LICENSE FEE FOR LAUNDRIES.

NO-X* AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENING OF WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS OF BAKERY PRODUCTS, DOING BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY.

NO-XI- AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENING OF WHOLESALERS OR RETAILERS, OF FRUITS OR VEGETABLES, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.
