AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL HELD IN THE CITY HALL OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, ON TUESDAY NIGHT, JUNE 21st, 1938. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT.

D.T. Keel, moved that Charlie Ratliff be hired by the City Council, as truck driver for the Fire Department, Assistant Jailor and general care taker of the Jail and fire stations, for the term beginning July 1st 1938, and ending the first Monday in January, 1940. at a salary of \$100.00 per Month, Subject to be suspended or removed for cause, at the will of the Mayor, to be approved by a majority of the City council. Said motion was seconded by L.M. Bacon, and all Four Members present voted Yes on said motion, same was duly carried.

ORDERED THAT:

James Matney, be and he is allowed the sum of \$39.00 for 13-Nights as special Policeman, as per bill filed and O.K'd by H. Carter Payable out of General funds.

ORDERED THAT:

J.M. Auier, be and he is allowed the sum of \$17.05. as per bill filed June, 21st 1938. Payable out of Criminal Prosecution funds.

ORDERED THAT:

Charlie Ratliff be and he is hereby hired as Truck driver for the Fire department, Assistant Jailer and General care-taker of the Jail and Fire Stations, for the Period Beginning July 1st 1938, and ending the First Monday, in January, 1940. at a salary of \$100.00 per Month, Subject to be suspended or removed for cause, at the will of the Mayor, to be approved by the majority of the council.

There being no further business before the Board, on motion to adjourn duly made, seconded and carried, council meeting was adjourned, until next regular meeting, Tuesday, July 5th 1938, 7-30, P.M.
