AT REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL, CONVENED AND HELD IN THE CITY HALL. IN PIKEVILLE, KY. ON THE 16th DAY OF AUGUST, 1938, AT 7-30 P.M.

BIDS: for hauling garbage, cleaning streets, and operating the incinerator, which had been filed with the City Clerk, upto 5 P.M. August the 16th, 1938. as was required by notice in the Pike County News, for Three issues in said paper. Was opened by the Mayor, which is as follows:

On motion of D.T. Keel, Seconded by Hayes Jones, the above referred to ordinance was passed by a unanimous vote of the council. all five members present voting yes for its passage, Thereupon the Mayor declared same passed and adopted and to be posted according to law.
