ORDERED THAT:

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING A LICENSE TO SELL DISTILLED SPIRITS AND WINES &c, WAS PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:

an ordinance requiring a license to sell distilled spirits and Wine at whole-sale. To sell distilled spirits and wine at retail by the package, for consumption off the premises, Setting the amount of fees for said license, Regulating closing hours for such retailers, And fixing penalties for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

Upon roll call of the vote all Five members present Voted yes, for the passage of the above ordinance. Thereupon the Mayor declared the Ordinance passed and same to be posted according to law.

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF MALT BEVERAGES &c. WAS INTRODUCED BEFORE THE COUNCIL WHICH IS AS FOLLOWS:

An ordinance providing for the licensing of malt beverage, distributors and Retailers, Requiring bonds, Providing for bond forfeiture, Setting the amount of license fees, Setting out hours during which retailers shall not sell Beer Providing for revocation of licenses, And setting out penalties for the Violation of the provision of this ordinance.

Upon roll call of the vote, All Five members present voted Yes. on the above ordinance, Thereupon the Mayor declared the ordinance passed, and same to be posted according to law.

ORDERED THAT:
