

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL CONVENED AND HELD IN THE CITY HALL IN PIKEVILLE, KY. ON TUESDAY FEBRUARY 21st 1939, AT 7-30. P.M. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT;

The reading of the former minutes was omitted and the following orders were made.

ORDERED THAT:

The Ky. & W.VA. Power Co. be and they are directed to furnish and install 1, 100 candle power street light near center of C. & O. drive way at its intersection with Huffman Avenue, under the supervision of Millard Burke, Fire Chief.

ORDERED THAT:

Susan Scott, be and she is hereby exonerated from paying City Tax Ticket to the City of Pikeville, for year 1937.

ORDERED THAT:

The map made by O.S. Batton, regarding Cline street, widening and reconstruction, for 1196 feet from Yost Street to station 29+00 near the Roy Daniels, lot, together with the figures added, to it in red, by W.P.A. is hereby ordered filed.

ORDERED THAT:

The sum of Five Thousand dollars be transferred by V.T. Bevins, City Treasurer, Treasurer from the Water Company profits, To the Master street paving fund, to be used to pay for balance on City's part on reconstructing Hibbard street, under W.P.A. And for Cline street repaving and widening project. and the City's part on other W.P.A. paving jobs.

ORDERED THAT:

J.M. Auxier be and he is allowed the sum of \$9.90 for commission on Tax collections, and taxi Fare. Payable out General funds.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND WIDENING OF CLINE STREET, WAS INTRODUCED, CAREFULLY READ, ACCEPTED AND APPROVED, AND ORDERED THAT AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND WIDENING OF CLINE STREET FROM STATION 17 PLUS 04, OPPOSITE THE INTERSECTION WITH YOST STREET, UP CLINE STREET FOR A DISTANCE OF 1,196 FEET, OR FROM STATION 17 PLUS 04 TO STATION 29 PLUS 00, FROM STATION 19 PLUS 60 TO STATION 26 PLUS 17 TO REMOVE THE PRESENT CONCRETE CURB AND GUTTER AND WIDEN THE EXISTING BRICK PAVEMENT WITH CONCRETE BASE TO CONFORM TO THE WIDTH OF THE TYPICAL SECTION THROUGH THIS DISTANCE, FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF CURB AND GUTTER ON BOTH SIDES OF SAID STREET FROM STATION 17 PLUS 04 TO STATION 29 PLUS 00, FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF SIDE WALK ON LEFT OR NORTH SIDE OF SAID STREET FROM STATION 17 PLUS 04 TO STATION 29 PLUS 00, AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CONCRETE RETAINING WALL ON THE RIGHT OR SOUTH SIDE OF THE SAID STREET, FOR A DISTANCE OF 400 FEET, OR FROM STATION 25 PLUS 00, TO STATION 29 PLUS 00,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, AS FOLLOWS.

The above ordinance was introduced, carefully read, accepted and approved, and upon roll call of the vote, all members of the council present voted yes for its adoption. Thereupon the Mayor declared the ordinance legally passed, and to be to be posted according to law.

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ORDERED THAT:

Miami Gravel Company, be and it is allowed the sum of \$103.78 for concrete sand and freight, Invoice of Date, Feb'y, 22nd 1939. Payable out of Master street funds.

ORDERED THAT:

Miami Gravel Company, be and it is allowed the sum of \$398.00 for 200 Bags of Portland Cement, Invoice of Date February 27th 1939, less 10 ¢ per Barrel, -\$20.00 Paid Warrant NO 1054, Dated March 1st 1939 Payable out of Master Street funds. (Warrant and Invoice given to Mayor Hi Pauley,)

No further business before the Board,
