

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

AT A REGULAR ADJOURNED MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL CONVENED AND HELD IN THE CITY HALL ON TUESDAY, APRIL, 25th 1939. AT 7-30 P.M. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT:

All previous minutes of the past council meetings, to date were read, discussed, approved, and accepted and signed.

The following business was transacted, as follows:

AN ORDINANCE WAS INTRODUCED BY THE CITY ATTORNEY., J.M. AUXIER, WHICH IS AS FOLLOWS:

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING IT TO BE A PUBLIC NECESSITY TO CONSTRUCT A GOOD USED 60,000 GALLON STEEL STAND-PIPE WATER TANK ON THE CITY'S LOT ON PEACH ORCHARD KNOB, PROVIDING FOR PURCHASING AND ERECTING SUCH A USED TANK? FOR PURCHASING AND LAYING OF APPROXIMATELY 4,000 FEET OF USED CAST IRON WATER PIPE TO CONNECT THE PROPOSED TANK WITH THE CITY'S WATER DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT ON SMITH HILL, AND FOR LAYING A WATER MAIN FROM PEACH ORCHARD KNOB TO THE SOUTHWEST END OF PEACH ORCHARD ROAD, AND FOR PURCHASING THE INSTALLING OF OTHER REQUIRED MATERIALS, AND FOR PROVIDING FOR THE LABOR ON ALL OF SAID WORK.

The vote resulting in Three in favor of the passing of the ordinance and One against it. Thereupon the Mayor declared the ordinance legally passed, and to be posted according to law.

ORDERED THAT:

J.M. Auxier, be and he is allowed the sum of \$5.50 for advanced Clerks fees in case of City of Pikeville, Vs/ Jerry Robinson & Wife. Payable out of General funds.

ORDERED THAT:

Rell Spears be and he is allowed the sum of \$8.00 for 8 hours labor for the City Payable out of Mesger street funds O.K. by Carl Young.

ORDERED THAT:

That the deed from K.S. McKinney and Rose McKinney & Co, Dated April 11th. 1939. To the City of Pikeville, Ky. for 7 by 108 feet strip of land on Garred Street be accepted and same is ordered filed in the County Court Clerk's office for record. All four members of the council present voted Yes on the above order.

ORDERED THAT:

The deed from J.P. Cline and Amba Cline his wife, To the City of Pikeville, Ky. Date April 12th 1939. conveying title to Garred Street, be accepted. and same is ordered filed in the County Clerks office of Pike County for record. All four members present voted Yes on the above order.

ORDERED THAT:

The deed from Sadie Newsom Charles and J.K. Charles, To the City of Pikeville, Ky. for a strip of land 30 feet wide running around Smith-Hill, and for additional necessary width, deed dated April 11th 1939. be Accepted, and same is ordered filed in the Office of the County Court Clerk for record. All four members present voted Yes on the above order.

ORDERED THAT:

The City Clerk is directed to advertise for Three weeks in the Pike County News, That the City will receive bids on One used 60,000 Gallon steel stand pipe water tank, 4,000 feet of 6 inch cast iron water pipe, one new centrifugal water pump sufficient to pump approximately 300 gallons of water per minute, against a 250 foot head.
