

# MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL CONVENED AND HELD IN THE CITY HALL IN PIKEVILLE, KY. ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER, 17<sup>th</sup> 1939. AT 7-30- P.M. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT.

The minutes and ordinances heretofore passed was approved and properly signed. by the Mayor and City Clerk.

ORDERED THAT:

Hi Pauley, Mayor, L.M. Bacon and Hayes Jones, Councilmen, negotiate with The Ky. & W. Va. Power Company, for said Company to install a 250 candle power street light on every other light pole, along the East side of College street, from Huffman Avenue to Hibbard street, and the same along the East side of Hibbard street from its intersection with College street to the upper bridge, i.e., remove ten 80 candle-power lights, replacing them with twelve 250 candle-power lights, over above route.

ORDERED THAT:  
Ky. & W. Va. Power Co. install a street light 80 candle power, in Alley between 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Streets, near the center of the alley, and opposite Dr. Kaminski and James Hatcher property.

Hayes Jones made a motion to transfer Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars, from the Water department profits, To the master street paving funds, L.M. Bacon seconded said motion, and V.E. Sevin, City Treasurer, is hereby ordered and directed to make said transfer. All four members present voted yes on the above order.

ORDERED THAT:

B.F. Sowards, (The Tavern) be and he is hereby granted a license to sell distilled spirits and wines at retail by the package, for consumption off the premises, at the Tavern on Main street Pikeville, Ky, from Oct. 8<sup>th</sup> 1939. To July 1<sup>st</sup>, 1940.

ORDERED THAT:

B.F. Sowards, (The Tavern) be and he is hereby granted a license to retail beer at the Tavern, on Main, street Pikeville, Ky. from Oct. 8<sup>th</sup> 1939. To July 1<sup>st</sup>, 1940.

ORDERED THAT:

Pikeville, Ice Co. be paid \$12.50 per Month rent on bulding for K.E.R.A. Payable at the end of each Month, for the Months of July, August, Sept. Oct. Nov. & Dec. 1939. Payable out of General funds.

ORDERED THAT:

That the checks payable by the U.S. Government to the City of Pikeville, Ky. for feeding and keeping Federal Prisoners, be deposited to the Criminal Prosecution funds, instead of the General funds.

All councilmen present voted yes on the above order.

The contract Dated May, 1<sup>st</sup>, 1939. for Ky. and W. Va. Power Company, Inc. to furnish the City of Pikeville, Ky. Electric power for a period, of Ten Years at the rates set out in the contract, was re-read, and general discussion was had on same. L.M. Bacon, moved that the City of Pikeville, Ky. enter into said contract with said Company, Charley Childers seconded said motion, That said contract be so executed by the City of Pikeville, Ky. with the Ky. & W. Va. Power Co. Inc.

All four members present voted Yes, on the above order.

There upon the Mayor declared said order passed/

ORDERED THAT:

Hi Pauley Mayor, sign as Mayor of the City of Pikeville, Ky. and execute on behalf of the City of Pikeville, and that H.S. Demron as City Clerk, attest;

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a contract Dated May, 1st, 1939. between th Ky. & W. Va. Power Company, Inc. and the City of Pikeville, Ky. for the said Kentucky and West Virginia Power Company, Inc. to furnish said City with electricity for a period of Ten Years. at the rate set out in said contract.

ORDERED THAT:  
Johnie Young, be and he is allowed the sum of \$81.00 for hauling stone for Cline street Job, Bill filed, Payable out of Master street funds.
