The reading of the former meeting was omitted, and the following business was transacted.

It was moved by Hayes Jones and seconded by T.J.Howell, that the following resolution be adopted.

June 18 1940.

Honorable Mayor, and  
City Council, Pikeville, Ky.

Regarding the acquisition of the GAS SYSTEM serving the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, which is now owned by the Southern Public Service Company, and on which you have asked for our assistance as to investigating the practicability and possibility of acquiring this System.

Negotiations as to price of the System to be handled directly between the City of Pikeville, and the Public Service Company, or the American Utilities Service Corporation.

In order to assist the City in determining upon an equitable price and an economical means of financing such a transaction, we hereby offer to perform the following services.

1. Due to the urgency of the situation, we will retain at our expense immediately, an engineer fully experienced in such matters, which engineer shall be agreed upon between the City and ourselves; to make a valuation of the Company's property, report of its physical condition, and a survey of such property. The engineer shall furnish a report to the City, which report shall include the projection of the gross earnings, operating expenses, and net earnings to be experienced under Municipal ownership and management.
2. We will retain at our expense, Chapman & Cutler, Chicago, Ill. to advise and assist your City Attorney in preparing the proceedings, and the issuance of revenue bonds to be payable solely from the revenue of the Gas System, and shall in no event become a general obligation of the city or be payable from city taxes, and the opinion of such attorneys will be furnished to all purchasers of the bonds, free of cost. We will also furnish the bond form blanks, free of cost.
3. In conjunction with the engineering report, we will advise the city as to the general form and plan of financing which will result in the lowest cost of financing.

It is understood and agreed that if the city decides to purchase the Gas System, and the bonds are issued, and when sold, the City will pay us a fee of 5% of the par value of the bonds issued, as sole compensation for the above services, The bonds will be sold at publicly advertised sale, and we will pay the cost of this advertising.

It is understood and agreed that in the event the Gas System is not purchased, and the bonds are not issued and paid for the city will be liable to us for no expense whatsoever.

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE EAST KENTUCKY BEVERAGE COMPANY, TO CONSTRUCT CONVEYOR LINES IN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, AND PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN POLICE REGULATION DURING CONSTRUCTION.
