## MINUTES CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular adjourned meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held in the city hall in the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, on the 23rd day of March, 1943, the following were present:

F. H. Sharp introduced an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPT-ING THE ASSESSMENT OF THE COUNTY TAX COMMISSIONER OF PIKE COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS OF JULY 1, 1942, AS THE BASIS OF AD-VALORUM TAX LEVIES FOR THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE FOR THE YEAR 1943; DIRECTING THE CITY ASSESSOR TO SECURE FROM THE COUNTY TAX COMMISSIONER OF PIKE COUNTY, KENTUCKY, a CERTIFIED COPY OF SAID ASSESSMENT LIST OF ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF PIKEVILLE, KEN-TUCKY, FOR SAID YEAR, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY, TO MAKE TAX TICKETS UPON THE VALUATIONS AS CERTIFIED FOR THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE FOR THE YEAR 1943 FROM SAID LIST AS CERTIFIED BY THE COUNTY TAX COMMISSIONER", and moved that said ordinance be passed and adopted. J. K. Hatmaker seconded said motion. Upon roll call the vote was as follows:

Yes; F. H. Sharp, J. K. Hatmaker, Yes; T. J. Howell, Yes; Charles R. Epperson, Absent; Charles E. Childers, Absent; Walter Walters, Absent;

Mayor, M. D. Flanary, Yes. The Mayor declared said motion carried and said ordinance duly passed and adopted.

J. K. Hatmaker moved that the salary of Gerty Osborne as helper to water department be raised from \$100.00 per month to \$120.00 per month, beginning April 1, 1943. F. H. Sharp seconded said motion. Upon roll call the vote was as follows: J. K. Hatmaker, yes; F. H. Sharp, yes; T. J. Howell, yes; Charles R. Epperson, absent; Charles E. Childers, absent; Walter Walters, absent. The Mayor declared said motion carried, after voting "yes", himself.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried Council is adjourned until its next regular meeting.
