

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held in the city hall in the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, on the 28th day of March, 1944, the following were present:

The minutes of the meetings of January 25th, February 8th, February 22nd and March 14th, 1944, were read and approved.

John M. Hatcher, City Clerk, filed receipt of A. J. Akers, Tax Collector, showing amount of penalties added to 1943 tax tickets by said city clerk, totaling \$148.71.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and unanimously carried the Kentucky and West Virginia Power Company is authorized and directed to install and erect one poll at water works plant at the cost of the city.

Upon motion made, duly seconded and carried bill of Edward Sackett in the sum of \$129.50, heretofore deducted from bill of United Carbon Company, is ordered to be repaid to United Carbon Company and deducted from bill of Eastern Kentucky Exploration Company.
