At a regular semi-monthly meeting of the common council of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky, convened and held in city hall on the 27 th. day of February, 1961, at 7:30 p.m. the following were present:

The city clerk read the minutes of the previous meeting. Upon completion the Mayor ask if there was any corrections or objections. The council having voiced no objections the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

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After the residents of South College Street spoke to the council about the problem of coal dust, Chief of Police, Woodrow Young, reported that the coal dock operators had complied with the ordinance. The Mayor ask Harry Hobson, Bill Huffman and J. A. Shockey to go with the Chief of Police, on Tuesday, February 28, at 2:00 p.m. to see if they could work out some solution to the coal dust problem on South College Street. The Council instructed Dan Jack Combs to check with state and County officials, to try to work out a compromise to get the dirt road portion of South College ~~hard~~ surfaced.
